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- ◆ Cortical visual impairment (CVI) is the most common cause of visual impairment in the US today.
- ◆ Children with CVI can have a normal eye exam but are unable to interpret what they see.
- ◆ CVI manifests in children who have difficulty with joint attention, have limited or no eye contact, are overstimulated by too much noise and clutter and prefer familiar objects to novel ones.
- ◆ Many kids with CVI are misunderstood and misdiagnosed as having ASD, ADHD, ID.
